On a valuation day, traded securities are to be valued at the last quoted closing price on NSE. NSE will be principal stock exchange and BSE will be the secondary stock exchange. Non traded Preference shares will be valued on the basis of norms governing the valuation of Non Convertible Debentures and Bonds under valuation of Debt Security category.
